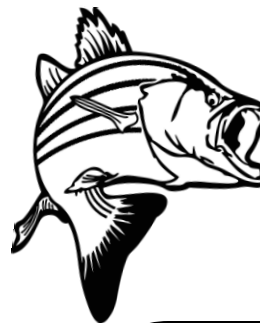


Tournament Rules

1. The Snug Harbor Midnight Madness Striper Tournament is a one-night fishing competition. A day lost to weather is a day lost to fishing.
2. The tournament is open to all desiring to enter. The **entry fee** is \$50 per angler. JR angler, 15 and under is \$25. All participants on vessel must be registered, no crew. This fee is non-transferable, unless so approved by the Tournament Committee. There shall be no provisions for the return or refund or entry fees.
3. **Specie and Size Limit.** The eligible specie is striped bass (*Morone saxatilis*). The minimum size limit for striped bass is 36". Minimum for Junior Anglers is 30". We encourage anglers to tag+release all undersized fish, as well as, any not intended for consumption. Call American Littorial Society, 732-291-0055 for tags.
4. Anglers may register one striped bass. In the event of a tie, the earliest registered fish is the winner. Decisions of the Weigh-In Committee shall be final. All fish remain property of the angler.
5. **Time Limits.** Lines in at 5am on Sat, Sept 9, 2018 and concludes with all lines out of the water by 10am on Sunday, Sept 9, 2018. ONE TRIP ONLY! All fish must be weighed-in and registered with the Tournament Committee. SCALE OPENS at 3pm to 5pm on Saturday, Sept 8 and 10am to 12pm on Sunday, Sept 9. NO BOAT FISH WEIGHED BEFORE 3pm Saturday or 10AM on Sunday. Winners will be announced at Sunday's Cookout + Awards Ceremony immediately following weigh-ins at Bon Vue Inn, 1230 Ocean Rd, Narragansett.
6. **Geographic boundary limits:** State Waters ONLY, no Federal Waters. All RI Fishing Regulations must be followed. All fish entered for awards consideration must be weighed at Snug Harbor Marina and registered with the Tournament Committee. The angler must present his/her numbered registration card in order to enter any fish.
7. Live bait, dead bait, or artificials may be used. No entangling device or material may be used. Any fish entered must be caught rod and reel in a conventional manner and fought exclusively by the registered angler. The fish cannot be mutilated.
8. Registered anglers cannot fish aboard a gill-net permitted vessel.
9. **Radio Channel.** VHF radio channel 66 will be utilized for all communications between participants and the Tournament Committee.
10. **Weather.** There is no Weather Committee. The tournament shall be conducted on a "fish at your own risk" basis.
11. All protests must be made in writing to the Tournament Committee and submitted by the close of the weigh-in period on the day of the alleged infraction. No other protests will be considered.
12. All fish are subject to examination of the Tournament Committee. Violations of tournament rules will not be tolerated. Any registered angler found in violation of the Snug Harbor Midnight Madness Rules will be disqualified.
13. Hidden Weight: All registered fish eligible, closest to drawn weight without going over wins, in event of tie, earliest registered fish wins.
14. Each award recipient must furnish his/her social security number and is responsible for any taxes levied by any state or federal tax-collecting agency. Prizes are accepted as awarded. The winner agrees that his or her photograph may be used for promotional purposes.
15. Participants enter the Snug Harbor Midnight Madness Striper Tournament at their own risk. Officials, committee members, employees of Snug Harbor Marina and all other persons connected either directly or indirectly with the operation of the 2018 Snug Harbor Midnight Madness Striper Tournament shall be exempt from any liability for loss, damage, negligence, harm, or injury suffered to any registered angler, their companions, boat captains, crew members, vessels, and equipment, which may occur during this tournament.
16. All decisions of the Tournament Committee shall be final.
17. Awards based upon angler participation. Posted prizes based on 100 anglers, otherwise prizes will be pro-rated. Proceeds donated to Pt Judith Fisherman's Fund.

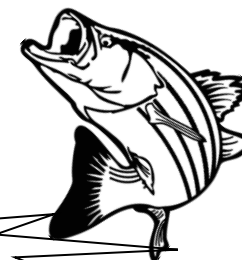
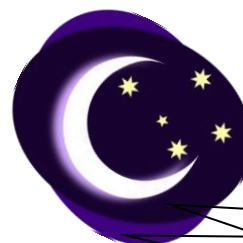
